## **CHAT AND CHEW: JANUARY 17**

On 17 Jan 2020, Dr. Eric Minus (SHS Principal) and staff members met with parents to discuss <u>Supporting Students in AP Level Courses</u>. AP NSL Gov. Teacher Ms. Michelle Games spoke to keeping your student motivated, while also providing a socially/emotionally safe environment while taking AP courses. She noted the importance of reading fluency to increase the likelihood of success in AP. She strongly encouraged as much reading as possible during the ES and MS grades. She also noted there is an expectation of independence, especially once students reach 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade. But there are a lot of support mechanisms for students in AP (and in general for all students).
